Ch1: vv4-5	John's preaching
Ch1: vv14-15	Jesus' preaching
Ch1: vv21-27+34+40-41	Jesus' preaching had authority but the stories are about healing.
Ch2: vv1-5+8-12+17	The connection between healing, forgiveness and salvation.
Ch4: vv26-29	Jesus teaches through parables. This one is unique to Mark.
Ch4: vv38-40	They woke Jesus and there was a great calm.
Ch5: vv18-20	Healing begs a response
Ch5: vv25-30+34	Faith, courage and healing
Ch6 vv7+12-13	Sent out to preach and to heal.
Ch7: vv1-3+6-8+20-23	Jesus' teaching about spiritual health.
Ch8: vv27-30	Who do people say that I am? Peter sees, albeit, briefly
Ch8: vv31-33	Jesus speaks of His suffering and death. Peter loses sight again.
Ch9: vv7-10	Transfiguration: collectively they are beginning to see.
Ch9vv17-29	It is the evil spirits who really see who Jesus is What does Jesus mean by Only prayer will work?
Ch10: vv33-39	James and John are beginning to understand; "rising to a glorious Kingdom"
Ch10: vv46-52	Is this just about physical sight, or did he get spiritual sight as well?
Ch11: vv12-14+20-21	The cost of fruitlessness.
Ch12: vv28-34	God's Kingdom ie, much fruit.
Ch12: vv41-44	If it doesn't cost, is it likely to bear fruit?
Ch13: vv9-11	An opportunity to bear fruit
Ch14: vv3-9	After all Jesus had taught, why would they be so angry? How must the woman have felt, and then after Jesus defended her?
Ch14: vv66-71	How quickly bravado can melt into fear. How could Peter have said such things?
Ch15: vv22-23	Why did Jesus refuse the wine and myrrh?
Ch15: vv38-39	"This man was really the Son of God"
Ch16: vv6-7	"Now go and tell....."
